May 23, 2010 PENTECOST SUNDAY

THEME: “To each individual the manifestation
of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” It has

been seven weeks and one day since Easter Sunday. It is Pentecost [from the Greek word for “fiftieth”], the day on which the Holy Spirit encourages the Apostles to proclaim Jesus Christ to people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. Each person heard the Apostles in their own tongue. Amazing! Even more amazing is that people with a variety of religious beliefs came to believe in Jesus. Later Paul writes to Christians in Corinth, a seaport city with people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. He tells them something so obvious we often forget it: Each of us is a person with unique array of talents, abilities and gifts that God has given to us to use for ourselves and for others. Material wealth, intelligence, artistic talent, athletic ability, the gift of music, and many others – God intends for us to enjoy them ourselves and to share them with others. How are we doing with that? One day God will ask.
