Eleventh Sunday of Ordinary Time

THEME: The one, I suppose, whose larger debt is forgiven” Kenny Rogers sings a Country Western Song, *“Oh Lord it is hard to be humble when you are perfect in every way.”* Could it be our theme song? Is the fact that we might be mistaken or wrong pretty far down on our list of possibilities? And we are proud of that? The ability to admit that we are in error or done evil does not come easy. For many people, the three most difficult words are not *“I love you,”* but *“I am wrong”* and *“I am sorry.”* And there is the always difficult *“I forgive you!”* Contrary to the song by Kenny Rogers, true humility is the willingness to say, *“I am wrong!”* and *“I am sorry!”* when necessary. And sometimes the best way we can give is to forgive. And the more we feel we have to forgive, the more we need to give. God gave us all that we have and area. Have we used all that God gave us as he intended? If not, have we said *I am wrong* and *I am sorry*? Our God is an awesome God. He wants to say, *I forgive you!* in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
